

THE DICKINSON CUP (WHS Handicap Index + to 20.0 playing off 95%)

Clubs are invited to hold qualifying Medal rounds in the month of May of the current year

Members may only enter the qualifying competition at their Home Club

Weekend and weekday competitions must be held but, should a player enter both, only her first score counts

The qualifier shall be the player returning the Best Nett score using 95% in the handicap category stated above. If the qualifier is unable to enter the Handicap Championship her place may only be taken by the next best score.

Ladies Competition Secretaries must notify the winners that they have qualified to compete for the Dickinson Cup at the Handicap Championship. They must also notify the name of the qualifier to the County Competitions Secretary by **30th June** using a form which will be available on the website.

Should a Dickinson qualifier increase her Handicap Index above 20.0 prior to the Handicap Championship she may still compete for the Dickinson Cup but must play off HI 20.0. Her score will still count towards any other prizes on offer at the Championship.

Any player entering the Handicap Championship Medal, even if not a Dickinson Cup qualifier, will also need to play off a maximum Handicap Index of 20.0, even if her HI increases above that level prior to the championship. She can choose to withdraw from the medal and enter the stableford competition instead, up to 48 hours prior to the championship.

Play will be in 3's - Please enter with partners, or individually and partners will be allocated.

Start sheets will be published on the SLCGA website and sent to the Club Delegates 14 days before the date of the Championship.
